## THE RAJASTHAN NON-GOVERNMENT EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2003

(Ordinance No. 2 of 2003)

[Made and promulgated by the Governor on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2003]

An Ordinance

Further to amend the Rajasthan Non-Government Educational Institutions Act, 1989.

WHEREAS the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly is not in session and the Governor of the State of Rajasthan is satisfied that the circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action;

NOW, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 213 of the Constitution of India the Governor hereby promulgates in the Fifty-fourth Year of the Republic of India the following Ordinance, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Rajasthan Non-Government Educational Institutions (Amendment) Ordinance, 2003.

(2) I shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3, Rajasthan Act No. 19 of 1992.—For the existing proviso to sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Rajasthan Non-Government Educational Institutions Act, 1989 (Act No. 19 of 1992), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"Provided that no institution shall be recognized unless it has been registered under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act, 1958 (Act No. 28 of 1958), or it is being run by a public trust registered under the Rajasthan Public Trusts Act, 1959 (Act No. 42 of 1959) or by a trust created in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 (Central Act No. 2 of 1882)."
