

Changes made in Pre-bid Meeting held on 8th July 2008

Tender Document For
Elementary Computer Education in Govt. Colleges of Rajasthan

A pre-bid meeting was held on 8th July 2008 at Shiksha Sankul, JLN Marg, Jaipur in connection with tender notification F 7(4) Acad/CompTender/08/182 issued on 25th June 2008 to clarify queries of the prospective tenderers in connection with Tender for Elementary Computer Education in Govt. Colleges of Rajasthan as per the clause 29 (page 17) of the tender document.

A tenderer is expected to take the changes into account while submitting technical and financial bids. It is mandatory to enclose a copy of these changes along with the bids. Kindly ensure that each page of it should be signed by the tenderer.
