उपरोक्त विषयान्तर्गत निदेशक (लोक), गृह मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार, नई दिल्ली ने पत्र मुख्य सचिव, राजस्थान सरकार को सम्बोधित कर भारत के राज्य चिन्ह और उसके अनाधिकृत उपयोग के अधूरे प्रदर्शन, भारत राज्य का प्रतीक (अनुचित प्रयोग का निषेध) अधिनियम-2005 और भारत के राज्य प्रतीक (उपयोग के विनियमन) नियम-2007 का उल्लंघन के संबंध में निर्देश जारी कराने हेतु अनुरोध किया गया है।

Subject:- Display of complete State Emblem of India with the motto "Satyameva Jayate" - Truth alone triumphs - written in Devanagari script below the profile of the Lion Capital.

Sir/Madam,

The State Emblem of India is the official seal of the Government of India. The State Emblem is an adaptation from the Sarnath Lion Capital of Asoka. The Emblem consists of the profile of the Lion Capital showing three Lions mounted on the abacus, with a Dharma Chakra in the centre, a bull on the right, a galloping horse on the left and outlines of Dharma Chakras on the extreme right and left with the motto "Satyameva Jayate" - written in Devanagari script below the profile of the Lion Capital [a copy of the design of the State Emblem of India is enclosed].

This Ministry had issued advisories dated 15th November 2007, 22nd September 2009, 7th September, 2010, 1st February, 2011 and 26th/29th July, 2011 in this regard. An advertisement regarding correct/proper use of the State Emblem of India was also published in 25 leading newspapers of India on 31.08.2011/01.09.2011. The correct/proper usage of the State Emblem of India was also broadcasted on Doordarshan on several dates.

3. In spite of this Ministry's aforesaid advisories and advertisements (print & electronic media) it has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that various Government agencies who are using the State Emblem of India on their stationery, publications, seals, vehicles, buildings, websites etc., often omit the motto "Satyameva Jayate" and are only depicting the profile of the Lion Capital. It may be noted that the State Emblem of India is incomplete without the motto "Satyameva Jayate" inscribed (in Devanagari script) below the profile of the Lion Capital.

4. It has also been brought to the notice of this Ministry that various individuals/authorities who are not authorized to use the State Emblem of India, are using the same on the stationery, vehicles etc. It may kindly be noted that the use of the State Emblem of India is restricted to the authorities/purposes specified in the aforesaid Rules.

5. Incomplete display of the State Emblem of India and its unauthorized use is a violation of the State Emblem of India (Prohibition of Improper Use) Act, 2005 and

the State Emblem of India (Regulation of Use) Rules, 2007. Contempt petitions have been filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta regarding incomplete display of the State Emblem of India,

6. It is therefore, again reiterated that the Government agencies who are authorized to use the State Emblem of India for various official purposes must depict the complete picture of the 'State Emblem' together with the motto "Satyameva Jayate" - in Devanagri script - inscribed below the profile of Lion Capital, as per the enclosed format and also to ensure that no unauthorized use of the State Emblem of India is made on stationery, vehicles etc.

7. Suitable instructions in this regard may please be issued to all concerned agencies. Strict action should be taken against the concerned officials (for incomplete display of the SEI) and individuals/organisations (who are using SEI unauthorizedly) for any violation in this regard.
